

## Documents requested for each type of horse

### For Horses In Training

- The partnership dissolution and termination of lease, signed by all partners

### For Foreign and exported horses

- An export certificate at your expense must be produced at the end of the sale for the destination country

### For broodmares

Coming out of training	Fillies' examination certificates are recommended
In foal	Please check the last service date and let us know of any changes ( <a href="mailto:pdeysine@argana-trot.com">pdeysine@argana-trot.com</a> )  A <b>Pregnancy certificate</b> dated less than eight days before the sale is strongly recommended
Sold with nomination already paid	<ul style="list-style-type: none"><li>○ <b>Covering certificate</b> and <b>Birth certificate</b></li></ul>
Sold with an unpaid nomination	<ul style="list-style-type: none"><li>○ A copy of the covering certificate</li></ul>
Sold with foal at foot:	<ul style="list-style-type: none"><li>○ The foal must be declared and a blood test to confirm parenting must be done</li></ul>

### For foals

The passport must be filled in and the graphic description must be undertaken by a vet if the passport has not yet been validated.

### For stallion shares

- The contract of joint ownership showing the number of the share you are putting up for sale
- The contract of sale

- You must notify the stallion manager by recorded delivery that the share is for sale

For stallions

- Up to date sperm analysis (recommended)
- EVA Test (required)
