



**Summer Mixed Sale 2018
Cabourg Racecourse**

A Consolidated market

The sales held on Friday 22 June at CABOURG Racecourse confirmed the positive trend that began at the beginning of 2018 with previous mixed sales, with sales of €1,225,000 (up 55% from 2017) with very positive indicators.

Indeed, with a percentage of sales (74%), an average price of over €13,000 and a median price of €8,000, these sales show that the market for the public sale of trotters is doing well.

READY CASH's brother GRAND CHELEM by LOVE YOU sold for €100,000

In addition to the growth of the market in general, the ready to run sector has equally seen some fine results,. The two-year-old GRAND CHELEM (LOVE YOU), a half-brother to READY CASH, was offered as qualified-unraced and was knocked down for €100,000 to Dutch agent Jack DE JONG acting on behalf of a German client.

For their part, the promising three year olds FILS PRODIGUE (LOVE YOU) and FORMI (TUCSON) both fetched the same prices, going the way for €60,000 to the Belgian Team CAMPUS RPF and to Mr Gilles RIVOALLAN (to join Ludovic PELTIER).

The cessation of activity of the stable of Mrs Jean DE MONDESIR generated for its part more than €300,000 of turnover, with only 2 lots (of 23) not finding a buyer. The promising FORMI (€60 000 seen above) and DISCO (€42,000) will join ne stables.

Of the breeding stock, 13 mares out of the 17 catalogued changed hands. The "DE MONDESIR" UDINESE presented in foal carrying a colt by DJANGO RIFF was

acquired for Mrs ALOISIO by NORMANDIE TROT for €45,000 and will join Haras d'Ecouché. VEGA WIC was finally knocked down for €35,000 on behalf of an investor wishing to remain anonymous.
